Latina/o Studies Undergraduate Minor

The Latina/o Studies Program offers an interdisciplinary minor in Latina/o Studies to undergraduate students in any college at Cornell with courses mostly drawn from history, sociology, anthropology, literature, language, government, and performance studies, but the program also cross lists courses from other colleges.

Requirements

The undergraduate minor is earned upon the completion of five courses (a minimum of 15 credits) in Latina/o Studies, including one of the introductory courses listed below. Students are welcome to count more than one of the introductory courses towards the five-course minimum.

Introductory courses:

- LSP 1802: Introduction to Latinos in U.S. History (cross listed with HIST 1802, AMST 1802)
- LSP 2010: Latinos in the United States (offered each spring semester, cross listed with DSOC 2650, SOC 2650, AMST 2655)
- LSP 2100: Introduction to Latina/o/x Studies (cross listed with AMST 2106)
- LSP 2XXX: Introduction to Latina/o/x Performance (cross listed with PMA, AMST)

Students are required to include at least three courses from Group I (Humanities) and Group II (Social Science) and must complete at least one course from each group. Of the three courses, two must be at the 3xxx or 4xxx level. One course from the elective category (<http://latino.cornell.edu/course-categories>) can count towards the minor. Courses must be completed with a letter grade of "C" or above.

Please note: You do not have to enroll under LSP in order for the courses to be counted towards the minor - you can register under the cross-listed department/program. Independent studies and Freshman Writing Seminars DO NOT count towards fulfilling minor requirements. Not all courses are offered each semester/year. Please refer to the roster and listing in the LSP office or on our web site at <http://latino.cornell.edu/academics/courses.cfm>. The list varies each semester in accordance with faculty schedules and visiting appointments.
